

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29, 1998 - 0530 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

Friday 10/30/98 will be the last daily report. We will begin weekly reports Friday 11/6/98 at 1000 MST through the winter, unless significant activity reported. The weekly reports will include the prescribed and WFU Year-to-date statistics.

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack fire activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for a helicopter and miscellaneous overhead. High fire dangers were reported in California, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia and Georgia.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CALVARY, Shenandoah NP. The fire is in bug killed timber from gypsy moth infestation. Dry conditions, rocky terrain and the amount of dead and down timber are causing control problems.

OUTLOOK:

A cool front will move toward southern California bringing strong gusty northwest winds late in the afternoon. Partly cloudy skies are expected with late night and early morning clouds and fog in the coastal areas and mountains. Arizona and New Mexico will be warmer with light winds. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's with 50's and 60's in the mountains and the lower 80's in the deserts.

Virginia will be mostly sunny with 10 to 20 MPH northwest winds diminishing by late afternoon. High temperatures will be in the 60's with mid 50's in the mountains.
