

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 1998 - 0900 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported nationally. Demobilization of resources continued in the Northern Rockies. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for large transport aircraft and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme indices were reported in Texas, Nebraska, Wyoming, South Dakota, Idaho, Montana, Washington, Oregon and Michigan.

NORTHERN ROCKIES LARGE FIRES:

CHALLENGE, Flathead NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Frye) is assigned. This fire is 40 miles east northeast of Kalispell. Weather conditions were favorable yesterday for locating and eliminating hot spots along the perimeter. Transition to a Type III Team will take place today.

Management of the fires will be returned to their respective forests today. This will be the last report unless significant activity is reported.

OUTLOOK:

The western United States will be mostly sunny. Eastern Montana across the central Rockies will have scattered showers and thunderstorms. West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be partly cloudy. East Oklahoma and east Texas will be cloudy with rain likely. Heavy rain is forecast in Arkansas. High temperatures will range from the 80's to low 90's.
