

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
THURSDAY, APRIL 1, 1999 - 1000 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Fire activity increased in the Southern and Eastern Areas yesterday. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for two crews, a type II helicopter, radios and miscellaneous overhead.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

DIVISION, Inyo NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Greenhoe) is assigned. The fire is located north of Independence near Highway 395. Some precipitation was received on the fire yesterday.

OUTLOOK:

Southern California and the Sierra Nevada mountains will be mostly cloudy with a chance of valley rain and mountain snow showers. High temperatures in the valleys and along the coast will range from the 50's to mid 60's and upper 30's to mid 40's in the mountains. Winds will be 10 to 20 mph from the northwest through Central California.

Variable cloudiness with scattered showers will prevail in Florida. A few thunderstorms will develop in the south and near the Keys. High temperatures will be in the lower to mid 80's except upper 70's on the southeast beaches. South to southeast winds at 5 to 15 mph.

A frontal system will move through Wisconsin today with a chance of rain across the northern and western sections. Temperatures will continue to be well above seasonal levels.
