

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, APRIL 16, 1999 - 1000 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity occurred in the Southern, Eastern, Northwest and Southwest Areas this past week. Increased initial attack fire activity was reported in the Northwest and Rocky Mountain Areas. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for 15 crews, 2 airtankers, 2 lead planes, 2 air attack aircraft, miscellaneous telecommunications equipment, approximately 70 overhead and one engine.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

PORT ST. LUCIE, Florida State. A FEMA declaration has been requested for this fire that has consumed at least 2,400 acres and 45 homes. No further information was available.

HICKORY ISLAND, Okefenokee NWR. This fire is burning near Folkston, GA. Fire activity was light yesterday despite strong winds.

OUTLOOK:

Florida will have scattered showers late today and Saturday, then becoming generally dry through next Thursday. Sunday and Monday will be windy. High temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's.

Arizona, New Mexico and west Texas will be mostly sunny through next week, except for a few showers over northern New Mexico today and Saturday. Windy conditions are forecast today and Saturday then returning again Wednesday and Thursday. High temperatures will range from the 50's in the mountains to the 90's in the lower deserts.

Southern California will be mostly sunny, except for a chance of showers Wednesday and Thursday. Winds 15-30 MPH are forecast this morning in the passes and canyons, otherwise no other significant winds are expected until Wednesday and Thursday. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's along the coast to the mid 80's and mid 90's in the inland valleys.
