

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY, APRIL 22, 1999 - 1000 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Unified Command has been established for the entire state of Florida. Good progress continues on most large fires despite adverse weather conditions. Mobilization was moderate yesterday. The National Coordination Center processed orders for aircraft, equipment, and miscellaneous overhead.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

HICKORY ISLAND, Okefenokee NWR. This fire is burning near Folkston, GA. The fire continues to grow to the northeast. Inaccessible terrain and heavy fuels are contributing to control problems.

APALACHICOLA COMPLEX, National Forests in Florida. A Type I team (Melton) is assigned. This complex includes the Owl Creek (2624 acres) and Cow House (6765 acres) fires. Both fires continue to burn actively in the afternoon due to low humidities, moderate wind, and persisting drought conditions. Interior swamp areas are burning out, causing spotting and hampering control efforts.

SINGECAT, National Forests in North Carolina. This fire is approximately 30 miles east of Asheville. The fire jumped the line yesterday. Air support was used for structure protection. Line construction and improvement continues.

OUTLOOK:

Florida will be mostly sunny with highs in the 80's. Expect southeast to southwest winds at 10 to 20 mph.

North Carolina will be mostly sunny and warmer with highs in the 80's. The northern mountains will be partly cloudy with southwest winds 15 to 25 mph.

*** FIRE WEATHER WATCH FOR SOUTHERN AND EASTERN NEW MEXICO AND FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR LOW RH'S AND GUSTY WINDS ***

New Mexico can expect southwest to west winds at 15 to 20 mph. Gusts to near 40 mph. The northern portion will see variable cloudy conditions with a chance of showers and thunderstorms. It will be partly cloudy in the south with high temperatures near 90.

Arizona will be cooler and windy with gusts up to 45 mph. Look for partly cloudy skies in the north and mostly sunny conditions in the south. High temperatures in the desert southwest will be in the lower 90's.
