

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 28, 1999 - 1000 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Florida continues to experience very high fire danger. Dry fuels, windy conditions and afternoon thunderstorms will contribute to new starts and potential control problems. High pressure over the Upper Great Lakes Region will keep fire indices very high for the next few days. Minimal new fires are occurring in the rest of the U.S.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

HICKORY ISLAND, Okefenokee NWR. This fire is burning near Folkston, GA. Higher humidities and southwest winds have aided suppression efforts. No new information was reported.
