

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, AUGUST 2, 1999 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported in most Areas. New large fires were reported in the Great Basin and Northwest Areas. Good progress was made on large fires in the Northern Rockies, Rocky Mountain and Eastern Great Basin Areas. The National Interagency Coordination Center mobilized engines, telecommunications equipment, type 1 and 2 helicopters, infrared aircraft, a single engine air tanker, smokejumpers and overhead personnel. High to extreme fire indices were reported in Oregon, Washington, California, Montana, Idaho, North Dakota, Utah, Nevada, and South Dakota.

NORTHERN ROCKIES LARGE FIRES:

SIX MILE, Gallatin National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Hoff) is assigned. This fire is thirty miles south of Livingston, MT. No major acreage gain occurred yesterday, but the potential for active fire behavior remains high as the weather becomes drier.

SPRING CREEK, Lewis and Clark National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Williams) is assigned. This fire is six miles northeast of White Sulphur Springs, Montana. No new information was received.

DEVIL STORM, Bitterroot National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Gauger) is assigned. This fire is 35 miles southwest of Darby, Montana in the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness. Suppression efforts have been aided by cloud cover. Fireline and spike camp rehabilitation is in progress.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

SHOSHONE BASIN, Upper Snake River District, South Central Idaho Area, BLM. This lightning caused fire is twenty-five miles south of Twin Falls, Idaho. Containment was expected last night.

SOLDIER, Salmon/Challis National Forest. A Fire Use Management Team (Johnson) is assigned. Two lightning ignited fires, thirty miles northwest of Stanley Idaho, are being managed to accomplish resource objectives. Heavy fuels and west winds along the southeast portion of the fire resulted in active fire behavior and an acreage increase. Cooler temperatures and cloud cover will aid hand crews today. Completion of fireline construction on Greyhound Ridge is expected later this afternoon.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

MARTIN, Winnemucca Field Office, BLM. This fire is burning, ten miles northeast of Paradise Valley, in grass and sage. Low relative humidity, low live fuel moisture and shifting winds hindered suppression efforts. The fire has spread from the flats into the foothills and steep terrain. Structure protection remains the top priority. Current threats are to cattle, structures, range allotments and the Martin Creek watershed.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR ALL OF MONTANA FOR ISOLATED DRY THUNDERSTORMS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITIES.***

Isolated to a slight chance of thunderstorms will be found over the entire western United States.

Arizona will have additional moisture pulled into the southwest around the Four Corners states later today, with an increase in thunderstorm activity expected.

The Rocky Mountains of northern Colorado and New Mexico will have increased scattered thunderstorms.

Morning low clouds and fog with drizzle will continue along the coasts, keeping the maximum afternoon temperatures to the 70's. High temperatures will increase to the 90's to 118 in the inland valleys and deserts. The mountains will see high temperatures from 70 to the mid 80's. Relative humidities will range from 10 percent in the lowlands and inland valleys, to near 50 percent along the coastal sections.

Winds will be light and variable across much of the west, with winds gusts to 25 MPH along the coast. Gusty winds are also expected to accompany thunderstorms.
