OUTLOOK:

Conditions will remain dry in the western portions of Texas and Oklahoma, including the panhandles. Eastern Oklahoma, southeastern Texas and southern Mississippi will have showers at times. Areas of Arkansas and

northern Mississippi will be rainy with 1-2 inches possible. High temperatures will be in the mid 60's to lower 80's except mid 50's through mid 70's Saturday and Sunday. South Texas will have highs in the mid 80's.

The Southwest U.S. will be dry through next week, except for a chance of showers in the Sierra Nevadas. There will be windy periods as several fronts will move through the area. High temperatures will generally range from the 40's and 50's in the mountains to the mid 70's and 80's in the lower deserts.
