

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
THURSDAY, JUNE 10, 1999 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Demobilization of resources from the Southern and Southwest Areas continued through the National Interagency Coordination Center. Initial attack activity was moderate in California, with minimal activity elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in New Mexico, Arizona, West Texas, Nevada, Utah, and Georgia.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

LA JARA, Cibola NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Bustamonte) is assigned. The fire is burning in timber 10 miles north of Grants, NM. No new information was received.

MT.EMMA, Grand Canyon NP. This fire was ignited by lightning, and is now being managed as a Wildland Fire Use Event. A Fire Use Management Team (Zimmerman) is assigned. The fire is burning 5 miles southwest of Tuweep Ranger Station on the North Rim of the Grand Canyon.

OUTLOOK:

New Mexico will be partly cloudy with a slight chance of evening thunderstorms in the east. High temperatures will be in the lower 70's to mid 80's in the mountains and north, and upper 80's and 90's in the south.

Arizona will be sunny. Winds will be southwest at 10 to 20 MPH. High temperatures will be 65 to 85 in the mountains and 85 to 103 in the valleys.

Northern Florida will be mostly cloudy with a chance of thunderstorms. Winds will be southeast at 5 to 15 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 80's.

Georgia will be partly cloudy with a slight chance of thunderstorms. Winds will be out of the east at 5 to 10 MPH. High temperatures will be 85 to 95.
