

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, JUNE 14, 1999 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity increased in Alaska due to lighting and hot, dry conditions. Large fire activity continued in the Western Great Basin, Alaska and Southwest Areas, while initial attack activity was minimal elsewhere. Mobilization of resources through the National Interagency Coordination Center included Infrared flight, radio equipment, and miscellaneous overhead. Forty smokejumpers, two Type I crews, aircraft and miscellaneous overhead are being mobilized to Alaska today. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, New Mexico, Arizona, West Texas, Utah and Nevada.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRE:

MT.EMMA, Grand Canyon NP. A Fire Use Management Team (Zimmerman) is assigned. This lightning ignited wildland fire is being managed to accomplish resource objectives. The fire is 5 miles southwest of Tuweep Ranger Station on the Grand Canyon's North Rim. The fires activity is mostly on the western and northern flanks.

ALASKA LARGE FIRE:

DONNELLY, Fort Greely Army Base. A Type II Incident Management Team (Jandt) is assigned. This fire is twenty-five miles south of Delta, AK. Control measures were hampered by 10 to 15 MPH west winds which pushed the fire approximately one mile, causing the evacuation of Fort Greely Army Base.

FAIRVIEW, Winnemucca Field Office. This fire is thirty-five miles northwest of Lovelock, NV. Control problems included rocky terrain, abandoned mine shafts, poor vehicle access and heavy fuel loading. Resources will continue working toward containment and mop-up objectives.

OUTLOOK:

Arizona will be partly cloudy with isolated thunderstorms in the south central and scattered afternoon thunderstorms in the southwest. High temperatures will be in the upper 70's in the mountains to near 110 in the lowest deserts.

Alaska upper Yukon, northern region and Tanana Zone will be partly cloudy with scattered afternoon showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be 75 to 80's. Winds will be southwest 10 to 15 MPH, expect gust from 15 to 30 MPH near Healy and Delta Junction.

New Mexico will be partly cloudy with widely scattered afternoon thunderstorms in the mountains and southwest. High temperatures will be in the 60's to low 80's in the mountains and northeast, and 80's elsewhere.

Northern Florida and Georgia will be mostly cloudy with scattered afternoon showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 75 in Georgia to around 90 in northern Florida.
