

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY, MAY 6, 1999 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity continues in the Eastern and Southern Areas. The Southwest and Southern California experienced minimal initial attack activity. Mobilization by the National Interagency Coordination Center included six crews, two helicopters and miscellaneous overhead for the Eastern Area, a lead plane for the Southern Area and six crews and an infrared aircraft for Ontario, Canada. Continued fire activity is expected in Canada, the Upper Great Lakes, New England states, Florida and the Southwest Area. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in New Mexico, Texas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Minnesota, Michigan, Maine and Wisconsin.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

SHOP RUN, Shenandoah NP. A Type I Incident Management Team (Melton) is assigned. This fire is 20 miles northwest of Charlottesville, VA. Hand crews and saw teams continue to make progress on line construction. Numerous snags continue to pose safety concerns. Airtankers delivered 22,000 gallons of retardant on the fire yesterday.

NEW GRADE, Florida State. This fire is located near Hollister Florida. Tractor/plow units, airtankers and helicopters are currently assigned. No other information was reported.

TOWER LAKE, Michigan State Forestry. This fire is north of the town of Republic. The town of Champion remains under an evacuation order. Roads into the area remain closed. Current control problems are rough terrain, access and very dry conditions.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

ROBERTS, Cibola NF. This fire continues to burn in the Apache Kid Wilderness, located near Magdalena. High winds are hampering control efforts. Crews hiked into the fire yesterday as high winds prevented transport by helicopter. Retardant drops were also canceled due to the high winds. The fire is active along the southwest flank. Packers continue to provide major support to crews on the line.

OUTLOOK:

A RED FLAG WARNING IS POSTED FOR WINDY CONDITIONS IN LOWER AND UPPER MICHIGAN. Michigan will see showers and thunderstorms. Minimum humidities will be 40-55 percent. Winds will be from the southeast at 15-25 MPH, with gusts to 30 MPH. High temperatures will be 65-80.

Minnesota and Wisconsin will see showers and thunderstorms. Minimum humidities will be 50-70 percent. Winds will be out of the northeast at 10- 20 MPH. High temperatures will be in the mid 50's to mid 60's.

Virginia will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Winds will be southeast at 5-10 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 70's.

New England will be partly cloudy with scattered showers in the south. Maine and New Hampshire will be dry. Minimum humidities will be 45-65 percent. High temperatures will be 65-80. Winds will be from the southeast at 5-15 MPH.

Florida will be sunny and warm. A cold front will move across the panhandle late this afternoon. KBDI indices remain high to extreme for much of the state. Minimum humidities will be 45-55 percent. Winds will be light and variable. High temperatures will be in the 80's to low 90's.

New Mexico will be partly cloudy. High temperatures will be in the 50's to 60's in the mountains, and lower 80's in the valleys. Winds will be northwest at 20-30 MPH.

Southern California will be sunny and warm. Minimum humidities will be 10- 15 percent north and 20-35 percent south. Winds will be southwest

at 10-20 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 60's to 70's in the mountains and 80's in the lowland valleys.
