

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
MONDAY, MAY 17, 1999 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Fire activity continued in the Southwest Area. The Southern Area experienced large fire and increased initial attack activity. The National Interagency Coordination Center Mobilized an Infrared aircraft and a few overhead. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Michigan, Arizona, New Mexico and Texas.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

FHU 634, Coronado NF. This fire is near Sierra Vista, AZ. Some structures were threatened, but winds died down diminishing the threat. Live ammunition in the area is a safety concern. Burn out operations are taking place.

OUTLOOK:

Florida will be partly cloudy with variable winds at 5-15 MPH. Minimum humidities will be 35-45 percent. High temperatures will be in the 80's

and 90's.

Northeast New Mexico will be partly cloudy, breezy and much cooler. The southeastern portion of the state will be mostly sunny. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 5-15 MPH. Minimum humidities will be 10-20 percent. High temperatures will be in the 50's to 60's for the mountains and far north. The rest of the state will be in the 70's to near 90.

Arizona will be sunny and warmer. Minimum humidities will be 5-14 percent in the west and 10-20 percent in the east. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 5-15 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 60's to 70's in the mountains and mid 80's to upper 90's elsewhere.

West Texas will be sunny with southwest to northwest winds at 10-20 MPH. Minimum humidities will be 10 to 20 percent. High temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's, and near 100 along the Rio Grande Corridor.

Michigan will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Winds will be southeast to southwest at 10-20 MPH. High temperatures will be in the mid 70's to the mid 80's.

Wisconsin will be partly cloudy with a chance of afternoon showers or thunderstorms. Winds will be south to southwest at 10-20 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 70's.
