

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 1999 - 0530 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Today will be the last daily report. Weekly reports will begin on Friday, 11/12/99 at 1000 MST throughout the winter, unless significant activity is reported. Weekly reports will include the prescribed fire and wildland fire use year-to-date statistics.

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity occurred in most Areas. Containment objectives were met on large fires in the Northern Rockies Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Utah, Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Colorado, North Dakota, Nebraska, South Dakota, Wyoming, Illinois, Indiana and Virginia.

NORTHERN ROCKIES AREA LARGE FIRES:

FRONTIER, Fort Peck Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs. This fire is located east of Wolf Point, MT. High winds and inaccessible terrain are hampering suppression efforts.

NORTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

FISH CREEK #2, Vale District, BLM. This fire is 14 miles northwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Steep, rocky terrain and high winds hindered containment efforts. Burnout operations are taking place to clean up areas of unburned fuel inside the fireline.

OUTLOOK:

High pressure will build over much of the west today. Some residual moisture from Thursday's cold front will still produce partly cloudy skies. Maximum temperatures will be in the 40's and 50's in the mountains and in the 60's in the valleys. Minimum relative humidities will be in the 30 to 60 percent range.

Southern California, southern Utah, and southern Nevada will continue to be dry with a broad area of surface high pressure resulting in light, variable winds over most of the area. Temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's with minimum relative humidities ranging from 10 to 20 percent.

High pressure will continue to build into Montana resulting in decreasing winds and slightly warmer temperatures. Maximum temperatures will range in the 50's and 60's with minimum relative humidities from 35 to 55 percent. Winds will be southwesterly 10 to 25 MPH with gusts to 30 MPH possible.
