

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 1999 - 1000 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

There was moderate initial attack activity in the Eastern and Southern Areas. New large fire activity occurred in the Southern Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Colorado, Wyoming, Indiana, Illinois, and Virginia.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

TOWN BRANCH #2, Daniel Boone National Forest. This fire is 3 miles east of Manchester, Kentucky. Unseasonably warm, dry, and gusty winds contributed to active burning conditions. Challenges to suppression include low humidity and steep terrain. Containment is expected today.

OUTLOOK:

Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky and Ohio will be dry and mild Sunday through Tuesday, except for a chance of showers in northern Ohio. Temperatures will be 55 to 75, cooling to the 50's and 60's Monday and Tuesday.

South Dakota will be dry and unseasonably warm over the weekend, with gusty winds Tuesday and Wednesday. There is a chance of showers Thursday. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's, cooling to the 50's and 60's Monday.

Southern Idaho, Utah, Wyoming, and Colorado will be dry and unseasonably warm through Monday. Valley rain and mountain snow will occur on Tuesday through Thursday. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's over the weekend, cooling into the 40's and 50's Tuesday and Wednesday.

California will be dry Friday through Sunday, except for a chance of rain along the north coast. Monday, there will be rain and mountain snow. Scattered showers Tuesday and Wednesday, with an increasing chance of rain and snow on Thursday. Highs will be in the 50's in the mountains, 60's and 70's in the valleys, and 80's in the deserts. Temperatures will drop 10 to 20 degrees on Monday and Tuesday.
