

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 1999 - 0800 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

There was moderate to high initial attack activity in the Eastern and Southern Areas. New large fire activity occurred in the Southern and Southwest Areas. The National Interagency Coordination Center mobilized a helicopter, an airtanker, large transport aircraft, leadplane, tactical aircraft, telecommunications equipment, crews and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Utah, Colorado, Kansas, North Dakota, Nebraska, South Dakota, Wyoming, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri, Arkansas and Oklahoma.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

BUZZARD CREEK, Daniel Boone National Forest. This fire is nine miles northeast of Whitley City, Kentucky. District personnel are completing burnout operations to assist with fire containment. No other information was received.

WHITTLETON BRANCH, Daniel Boone National Forest. This fire is seven miles northwest of Campton, Kentucky. Containment is expected today at noon. Mop-up is continuing near the fireline.

TOWN BRANCH #2 COMPLEX, Daniel Boone National Forest. This complex is three miles east of Manchester, Kentucky and consists of seven fires ranging from 1 to 776 acres.

PONTZER, Virginia Department of Forestry. This fire is ten miles north of Woodstock, Virginia. The fire is burning in steep terrain and gypsy moth killed timber which is hampering containment objectives.

DOG SLAUGHTER RIDGE 99, Virginia Department of Forestry. This fire is seven miles northeast of Shenandoah, Virginia. The fire is threatening the Shenandoah National Park. Crews are trying to clean out and utilize an old dozer line from a previous fire several years ago. Containment objectives are being hampered by steep terrain.

BLOOD COMPLEX, Georgia Interagency Coordination Center. This fire is near Blairsville, Georgia. A Type I Incident Management Team (Melton) is assigned. Two fires are burning within the Blood Mountain Wilderness. There is no estimate of containment at this time.

BROKEN COMPLEX, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest. This fire is eight miles west, northwest of Heber, Arizona. Approximately seven miles of roadway had been ignited by persons unknown. The fire is burning in an active timber sale and harvested log decks are threatened.
