

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
MONDAY, APRIL 10, 2000 - 1000 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fires occurred over the weekend in the Southwest and Eastern Areas. Initial attack activity was also reported in the Rocky Mountain, Southern, and Northwest Areas. Orders for a lead plane, a caterer, and miscellaneous overhead were processed through the National Interagency Coordination Center. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Missouri, and Virginia.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

PADDY CREEK, Ft. Apache Agency. A Type II Incident Management Team (Leech) has been assigned. The fire is burning in ponderosa pine near White River, AZ. Steep, rugged terrain and limited access are challenging containment efforts.
