

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY, APRIL 13, 2000 - 1000 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationwide. All large fires in the Southwest Area have been contained. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona and Virginia.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

MERRITT, Florida Division of Forestry. A Florida State Type II Incident Management Team has been assigned. The fire is burning 10 miles southeast of Naples, FL, in palmetto and cabbage palm tree vegetation. A fire engine working on the incident was burned over yesterday. The two operators escaped injury. A wind shift pushed the fire back into burned areas.

Arizona and New Mexico will be mostly sunny and warmer. High temperatures will be in the mid 60's in the mountains, and in the mid 90's in the southern valleys. Winds will be southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

Florida will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms throughout the state. Temperatures will be in the mid 70's in the north and in the mid 80's in the south. Winds will be east to southeast at 5 to 15 mph.

North Carolina will be mostly cloudy with a chance of rain. Highs will be in the 50's inland and in the 60's near the coast. Winds will be

northeast to east at 5 to 15 mph.
