

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 19, 2000 - 1000 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

The Southwest, Rocky Mountain, and Southern Areas reported new large fires. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for crews, a caterer, a shower unit and miscellaneous overhead requests. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Colorado and Kansas.

SOUTHWEST LARGE FIRES:

RIO GRANDE COMPLEX, Socorro District, New Mexico State Forestry. This complex consists of six fires burning 30 to 60 miles south of Albuquerque, NM. A Type II Incident Management Team (Bustamante) is assigned. Various buildings are currently threatened by the fires and some evacuations in the communities of Contreras and Belen, NM have occurred. High winds are hampering suppression efforts.

BRANTLEY, Roswell - Carlsbad Field Office, Bureau of Land Management. This fire is located 15 miles northwest of Carlsbad, NM. The cause of fire is currently under investigation and structures are being threatened.

PICACHO, Capitan District, New Mexico State Forestry. The fire is burning east of Ruidoso, NM. The fire is inaccessible to engines and firefighting is mainly being accomplished by hand crews.

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN FLORIDA FOR LOW HUMIDITIES. ***

Florida will be sunny with minimum relative humidities in the 25 to 35 percent range. Winds are forecast to be out of the northwest and northeast at 5 to 15 mph.
