

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
MONDAY, APRIL 24, 2000 - 1000 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fires were reported in Missouri and Minnesota over the weekend. Otherwise fire activity was quiet nationwide. The National Interagency Coordination Center mobilized a caterer and miscellaneous overhead. Numerous units in Arizona and New Mexico reported very high to extreme fire indices. Other states reporting very high to extreme fire danger included Oklahoma, Texas, Illinois, Missouri, Wisconsin, and Georgia.

EASTERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

DOG PACK, Mark Twain National Forest. The fire began on 4/20, 12 miles west of Poplar Bluff, MO. It is burning in hardwoods and leaf litter. Threats include timber, private land, and the local watershed. Forecast precipitation did not materialize. Containment is expected today.

OUTLOOK:

High pressure aloft will cause Arizona and New Mexico to become warmer and drier today. Partly cloudy conditions will be present in the northern part of both states, while it will be sunny in the south. Temperatures will be in the upper 60's and 70's in the mountains, and from 80 to the low 90's in the southern desert areas.

Northern Florida will have scattered showers and thunderstorms, as a low pressure system moves through the southeast states. The thunderstorms may become severe later in the day. High temperatures will be in the upper 70's. Winds will be southwest at 15 to 25 mph.
