

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, MARCH 24, 2000 - 1000 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

No new large fires were reported to the National Interagency Coordination Center this week. Initial attack activity has been light in the Southern, Eastern, Southwest, and Southern California Areas. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Texas, New Mexico, and Arizona.

OUTLOOK:

Arizona will be partly cloudy this weekend with high temperatures in the 50's in the north and 70's in the south. The rest of the week will be windy and cooler with a chance of valley showers or mountain snow. Temperatures will be in the 30's in the mountains and 60's elsewhere.

Texas will be partly cloudy with patchy morning drizzle in the southwest. Tuesday and Wednesday will be breezy and cloudy with a chance of showers in the south. The remainder of the week will see a return to more normal conditions.

Florida will be partly cloudy this weekend with high temperatures in the 70's in the north and 80's south. Monday and Tuesday the forecast is for a chance of thunderstorms in the north and a slight chance of showers in the south. Wednesday will see a return to normal daily temperatures with little or no precipitation anticipated for the area.
