

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, MAY 5, 2000 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Florida had one new large fire yesterday. Most of the fires in Minnesota were contained. Resource mobilization through the National Interagency Coordination Center was minimal. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, New Mexico, Utah, Nevada, Wyoming, Michigan, Minnesota and Wisconsin.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

LONG BAY, National Forests of Florida. This fire is burning in the Apalachicola National Forest 40 miles southwest of Tallahassee, FL. A Type I Incident Management Team (Melton) is assigned. The fire was active with spotting reported of up to 1 mile in distance. Airtankers and helicopters helped to support suppression efforts.

ELBOW LAKE, Minnesota State Forestry. The fire is near Orr, MN at the west end of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area. Effective use of air resources resulted in slowing the fire s growth.

COON CREEK, Tonto National Forest. The fire is 20 miles north of Globe, AZ in the Sierra Ancha Wilderness. A Type I Incident Management Team (Bateman) is assigned. Crews constructed fireline on the south edge of the fire and air support slowed the fire s advance on the north side. Plans

to build some indirect fireline are currently being considered.

Florida will be partly cloudy today with a chance of thunderstorms in the Panhandle. There is also a slight chance of showers in the southern part of the state. Winds will be east to southeast at 10 to 15 mph. High temperatures will be in the 80's.

Minnesota, Wisconsin and Lower Michigan will be partly cloudy with isolated showers and thunderstorms over northern Minnesota and lower Michigan. High temperatures will be in the mid 80's. Winds will be south to southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

Arizona and New Mexico will be sunny. Winds will be southwesterly at 10 to 20 mph. High temperatures will be in the 70's in the mountains and up to 107 in the southern deserts.
