

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2000 - 1000 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light in the Southern Area and no new large fires were reported. Containment goals were reached on one large fire in Tennessee. High pressure aloft will dominate the Southern Area until early next week when the next chance of moisture approaches the area. North Carolina and Virginia are still reporting very high to extreme fire danger indices.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

SHENANDOAH COMPLEX, Shenandoah National Park. A Type I Incident Management Team (Stutler) is assigned. This complex consists of the Pinnacles and the Old Rag fires, which are five miles southeast of Luray, VA. Crews made significant progress completing rehabilitation.

SOUTHEAST DISTRICT COMPLEX, Kentucky State Division of Forestry. A Type I Incident Management Team (Frye) is assigned. These fires are in several counties surrounding Pineville, KY. No new information was received.

OUTLOOK:

Dry high pressure aloft will move to the Atlantic Coast in the afternoon allowing mid and high level clouds to invade the area west of the Appalachians by late afternoon. A cold front will move out of the central plains Sunday night and be in western Tennessee and Kentucky Monday morning. Rain will spread over Tennessee and Kentucky throughout the day. West of the Appalachians high temperatures will range from the lower 50 s to the lower 60 s with minimum relative humidity of 30 to 40 percent. East of the Appalachians high temperatures will be in the 60 s with minimum relative humidity in the 40 s. Winds will be variable at 5 to 10 mph over the region.
