

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2000 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Light initial attack activity was reported in California, Eastern Great Basin, Southern, and Eastern Areas. A cold front moving across the northwest has moderated fire activity in the western states. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Idaho, Texas, and Montana.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

JOURNEY, Six Rivers National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Szczepanik) is assigned. This fire is 15 miles southeast of Mad River, California. The fire is receiving some precipitation and demobilization is occurring.

There will be cooler and unsettled weather for California and southern Oregon as a strong area of low pressure stalls over the Great Basin today. As a result, widespread valley rains and scattered mountain snow are possible. Snow levels will be in the 5000 to 6000 ft range in the north and to 7000 ft in southern California. High temperatures will be in the 40's in the mountains and 50's to lower 70's inland. Minimum relative humidity will be from 30 to 50 percent and winds should be out of the northwest from 10 to 20 mph.
