

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SATURDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2000 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light throughout the nation. One new large fire was reported in the Southern Area. Containment goals were reached on three large fires, one in the Eastern Great Basin and two in the Southern Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Kansas, Oklahoma, Colorado and Montana.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

BOAR CREEK, Oklahoma Division of Forestry. This fire is located three miles southeast of Hominy, OK. High winds and low relative humidity made containment difficult. Current threats are to homes.

PRIVATE, Texas State Forest Service. This fire, located 80 miles north of Houston, TX, is burning in a pine plantation. No new information was reported. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR MISSISSIPPI AND EASTERN KENTUCKY FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY. ***

In Southern California, high pressure aloft will continue to build over the region, bringing slightly warmer and drier conditions. It will be sunny, with high temperatures ranging from the upper 50's and 60's in the mountains, to the lower 90's in the warmest deserts. Minimum afternoon relative humidity will be 15 to 25 percent in the deserts and 25 to 35 percent elsewhere. Winds will be north to northeast at 5 to 15 mph.

In the South, high pressure will remain over most of the region, causing warm and dry daytime conditions. Maximum temperatures should be in the high 70's to low 80's, with cool nights in the 50 degree range.
