

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2000 - 0900 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

No new large fires were reported in the nation. Initial attack activity was light. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Minnesota.

EASTERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CARLOS EDGE, Minnesota State Forestry. A State Incident Management Team (Stegmeir) is assigned. This fire is six miles from Wyoming, MN. The fire is burning in grass, peat and mixed hardwood fuels.

ST. CROIX, Minnesota State Forestry. A State Incident Management Team (Bonde) is assigned. The fire is in Pine County, west of Grantsburg, WI. Northwest winds are causing containment problems in this pine and hardwood litter fueled fire.

LIMESTONE, Oklahoma State Division of Forestry. This fire is eight miles southeast of Collinsville, OK. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

COMO, Carson City Field Office. This escaped prescribed fire is 15 miles southeast of Carson City, NV. Fire behavior has been greatly reduced due to lower temperatures and higher relative humidity. Current threats are to wildlife habitat, grazing forage and two local cabins.

OUTLOOK:

Southern California will experience strong north to east winds 30 to 40 mph with gusts to over 60 mph on the ridges. It will be partly cloudy with a slight chance of showers mainly south and east of Los Angeles. Temperature highs will be in the 70's and 80's. Minimum relative humidity will be 15 to 30 percent in the canyons and passes, and 35 to 50 percent elsewhere.

Minnesota will be mostly cloudy with a few showers. High temperatures are expected to be in the 60's. Winds will be south at 10 to 20 mph. Minimum relative humidity will be 30 to 35 percent in the north and 40 to 50 percent in the south.
