

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
MONDAY, JUNE 4, 2001 - 0530 MDT  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

One new large fire was reported in southern California. Three large fires reached containment in Montana, New Mexico and Colorado. Initial attack activity has been light in most areas. Fire indices were very high to extreme in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico, Texas and Utah.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

TRAP AND SKEET, Mescalero Agency, BIA. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Humphrey) is assigned. This fire started three miles south of Ruidoso, NM. Significant progress was made in fireline construction and containing the existing perimeter. Numerous spots were discovered across the fireline. A precautionary evacuation of a subdivision is in effect for a minimum of twenty four hours.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

BIG, Shasta-Trinity National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management team (Szczepanik) is assigned. This fire is located 14 miles west of Weaverville, CA. Cross slope winds out of the west and northwest did not greatly affect fire behavior. Steep terrain and only one road into the area are impeding containment efforts.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

DIXIE/LAFAYETTE COMPLEX, Florida Division of Forestry. A State Type 2 Incident Management Team (Koehler) is assigned. This fire is 25 miles

north of Perry, FL. High winds caused needle fall promoting re-burn inside the perimeter.

GATOR SLOUGH, Florida Division of Forestry. This lightning caused fire is burning in a swamp and is completely inaccessible. No new information was reported.

CRAVEN ISLAND, Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge. A Fire Use Management Team (Cook) is assigned. This fire is near Minnies Island, GA. Deactivation of structure protection measures for Stephen Foster State Park is underway. Assessment of long term fire potential of the fire continues.

LEMONS GAP COMPLEX, Texas State Forest Service. This fire is burning in grass, pinyon pine and juniper 32 miles east of Marathon, TX. This complex is comprised of the Lemons Gap, Right Hand Canyon and Pine Peak fires. A new fire, Ryan Ranch has been added to the complex. It is currently 80 acres and burning in steep canyons.

OUTLOOK:

\*\*\* A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR THE MOUNTAINS AND WESTERN PORTION OF NEW MEXICO DUE TO STRONG WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY \*\*\*

A dry southwest flow over New Mexico and Arizona will bring mostly sunny skies except for a few thunderstorms over northeast New Mexico. High temperatures will be in the 70's in the mountains to near 105 in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to 15 percent. Winds will be generally southwest to west at 15 to 25 mph.

High pressure will build over northern California bringing mostly sunny skies with low clouds along the coast. High temperatures will be in the 60's along the coast and in the 80's inland. Minimum relative humidity will range from 15 to 30 percent over the inland area. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 10 to 20 mph.

High pressure over Florida with moisture increasing from the south will bring partly cloudy skies with scattered thundershowers. High temperatures will be in the 80's to low 90's. Minimum relative humidity will range above 45 percent and winds will be south at 5 to 15 mph.

A cold storm system moving over Montana will bring widespread rain and mountain snow. High temperatures will be mostly in the 40's and 50's. Winds will be mostly southwest to northwest at 10 to 20 mph

Colorado will have partly cloudy skies with a few thunderstorms along the west slopes and scattered showers and thundershowers elsewhere. High

temperatures will be in the 50's and 60's except for the western valleys which will be in the 70's. Winds will be southwest to west at 10 to 20 mph.
