

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 6, 2001 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Five new large fires were reported in Florida and Arizona, four of which reached containment. Initial attack activity was moderate in Florida and northern California, and light elsewhere. Fire indices were very high to extreme in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, Texas, and Utah.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CRAVEN ISLAND, Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge. A Fire Use Management Team (Cook) is assigned. This fire is near Minnies Island, GA. The fire was active on the south and northeast sides but had no appreciable acreage gain. A long term fire management plan is being prepared.

FOUR MILE RUN, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Conservation Area 3A and is currently in monitor status.

DIXIE/LAFAYETTE COMPLEX, Florida Division of Forestry. A State Type 2 Incident Management Team (Koehler) is assigned. This fire is 25 miles north of Perry, FL. No new information was reported.

PARRISH, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is near the Duette Park Recreation Area. No new information was reported.

REFLECTION, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is 13 miles east, southeast of the Orlando airport. No new information was reported.

SQUAWK CREEK 2, Everglades National Park. These fires are four miles west of the Pa-Hey-Okee overlook in the Squawk Creek area and are in monitor status. No new information was reported.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

TRAP AND SKEET, Mescalero Agency, BIA. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Humphrey) is assigned. This fire started three miles south of Ruidoso, NM. A few hot spots remain and mopup continues further into the interior of the fire.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

BIG, Shasta-Trinity National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Szczepanik) is assigned. This fire is 14 miles west of Weaverville, CA. No new information was reported.

OUTLOOK:

High pressure continues to bring a moist southerly flow into Florida producing partly cloudy skies and scattered thundershowers. High temperatures will be in the mid 80's to mid 90's. Minimum relative humidity will be above 40 percent and winds will be southwest to southeast at 5 to 15 mph.

High pressure over the Southwest and western Texas brings a decrease in wind speeds and a warming trend. Sunny skies are expected over the region except for a few thunderstorms in northern and eastern New Mexico. High temperatures will be from the mid 70's to mid 80's in the mountains and 105 to 110 degrees in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to 15 percent. Winds will be variable at 10 to 20 mph.

High pressure continues to build over California bringing sunny skies, warmer and drier weather and light winds. Coastal areas will experience low clouds and fog. High temperatures will be in the mid 60's to mid 70's along the coast, from the mid 80's to mid 90's inland and reaching 105 to 110 degrees in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to

15 percent over the inland area. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 5 to 15 mph, with gusts to 20 mph in the mountains.

A high pressure system over most of the Great Basin will bring sunny skies and a warming trend. High temperatures in the valleys will be in the 70's and 80's, and 100 to 110 degrees in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to 15 percent, with winds from west to southwest at 10 to 20 mph.
