

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, JUNE 19, 2001 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Six new large fires were reported in Florida, with three being contained. Initial attack activity was moderate in Northern California and Southern Areas, and light elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Colorado, Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, Utah and Wyoming.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

MARTIS, Nevada-Yuba-Placer Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. A Unified Command with a California Department of Forestry Type 1 Incident Management Team (Posten) and a U.S. Forest Service Type 1 Incident Management Team (Gelobter) is in place. This fire is burning east of Truckee, CA and has burned into the Rose Mountain Wilderness Area. The fire continues to threaten communities west of Reno. Contingency plan preparation work is underway.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

SHINN, Angeles National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Domanski) is assigned. This fire is burning in steep terrain with limited access two miles north of Upland, CA. The Cucamonga Wilderness Area and isolated summer cabins are potentially threatened. Steep, inaccessible terrain is hampering containment efforts. Air operations have been effective in slowing the fires spread.

HEMLOCK, San Bernardino National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Walker) is assigned. This fire is six miles northeast of San Bernardino, CA.

CANYON, San Bernardino National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Wendt) is assigned. This fire is burning in steep, rocky terrain in Bautista Canyon, CA.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

EAST COUNTY LINE, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire started on 6/12 in Broward County, one mile from US Highway 27. No new information was reported.

TAYLOR RANCH, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is located in Sarasota County, FL. Night operations have completed containment lines around most of the fire.

CROSS OVER, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Broward County, FL in the Everglades Conservation Area. No new information was reported.

PINE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Sarasota County, FL. Personnel continue to monitor this fire.

BLACK HOLE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Broward County, FL.

BIG DADDY COMMAND, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is located in Palm Beach County, FL. Burnout operations slowed fire spread.

CHERRY LAKE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is located in Lake County, FL. Burnout operations are being planned to assist in containment.

CRITICAL, Florida Division of Forestry. This lightning caused fire is in Pasco County, FL. No new information was reported.

TOMBSTONE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Broward County near the East County Line fire and was caused by lightning. No new information was reported. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

ROLF, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Orange County, FL. No new information was reported. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

OUTLOOK:

Strengthening high pressure over California will bring sunny skies to the interior, with fog and low clouds along the coast. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's along the coast, in the mid 70's to upper 80's in the high mountains, 95 to 105 in the central valley, and 108 to 116 in the southeastern deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 10 to 20 percent and afternoon winds will be southwest to northwest at 8 to 15 mph.

High pressure continues over Arizona and most of New Mexico. There is enough moisture over New Mexico and southeast Arizona for some isolated afternoon and evening thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's, and 102 to 113 in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range mostly from 10 to 20 percent, except for 5 to 12 percent in the deserts. Winds will be southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

Nevada and Utah are under the same high pressure. Temperatures will be in the 80's in most areas, and 110 to 115 in southern Nevada. Minimum relative humidity will range from 10 to 15 percent, to as low as 5 percent in southern Nevada. Winds will be west to southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

High pressure has returned to Florida bring partly cloudy skies with scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the upper 80's and lower 90's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 55 to 65 percent, with winds from the east at 10 mph.
