

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SATURDAY, JUNE 23, 2001 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Seven new large fires were reported, four in Florida and one in New Mexico. Six large fires reached containment in Florida, and one in southern California. Moderate initial attack activity was reported in California, the Southwest and Southern Areas. Initial attack activity was reported as light elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, Utah and Wyoming.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

MARTIS, Nevada-Yuba-Placer Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. A Unified Command with a California Department of Forestry Type 1 Incident Management Team (Posten) and a National Type 1 Incident Management Team (Gelobeter) is in place. This fire is east of Truckee, CA and has burned into the Mt. Rose Wilderness Area. Contingency plans continue for an anticipated wind event this weekend. Interior islands of fuel remain active. Inaccessible terrain is impeding containment efforts.

WHITETAIL, Gila National Forest. This lightning caused fire is 60 miles northwest of Truth or Consequences, NM and is being managed to meet resource objectives. Afternoon winds related to thunderstorms in the area created some perimeter growth.

OUTLOOK:

*** A RED FLAG WARNING HAS BEEN POSTED EAST OF THE CASCADE/NORTHERN SIERRA CREST IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AND WESTERN NEVADA FOR STRONG WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY ***

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED IN SOUTHEAST IDAHO FOR DEVELOPING STRONG SOUTHWEST WINDS ***

A trough approaching the West Coast will bring strong winds across California, Nevada, and southern Idaho along with mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies. High temperatures will be cooler, in the 80's and 90's, except for 100 to 108 in the southern deserts. Minimum relative humidity will be 5 to 15 percent. Winds will be south to southwest at 15 to 30 mph with gusts 35 to 45 mph over the highest terrain.

High pressure will continue over the core of mainland Alaska. Winds and humidity have moderated in the central interior. High temperatures will be in the 70's with minimum relative humidity ranging from 20 to 35 percent. Winds will be variable around 5 mph.

Moisture flowing around the high pressure centered in the Southwest will continue to bring some afternoon showers and thunderstorms to Arizona, New Mexico and Utah. High temperatures throughout the area will be in the 80's and 90's with 100 to 105 in the Arizona and Utah deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 10 to 20 percent. Winds will be south to southwest at 15 to 25 mph with gust up to 35 mph in some areas of New Mexico.

A cold front will be moving very slowly east across Virginia with partly to mostly cloudy skies and scattered showers or thunderstorms. High temperatures will be from the lower 70's to lower 80's, and minimum relative humidity around 55 percent. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 10 mph.

Florida will remain under a moist southerly flow with high pressure to the east bringing mostly cloudy skies and fairly wide spread showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 80's and low relative humidity will range around 60 percent. Winds will be southwest at 7 to 10 mph.
