

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 27, 2001 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Four new large fires were reported, one each in Alaska and New Mexico, and two in Florida. Three large fires were contained, one each in Montana, Idaho and Florida. Initial attack activity has slowed but is still somewhat moderate in California, Southwest and Southern Areas due to higher humidity and precipitation. Initial attack activity was light elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Utah.

ALASKA AREA LARGE FIRES:

FISH CREEK, Fairbanks Area, Alaska Division of Forestry. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Jandt) is assigned. This fire is 12 miles southeast of Nenana, AK. Fire activity has been moderate due to increased relative humidity. Good progress has been made with fireline construction on the southwest perimeter. Protection needs at cabins and allotments are being assessed; sprinklers will be deployed as needed.

NORTH SHORE KENAI LAKE, Chugach National Forest. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Hefner) has been assigned. This escaped prescribed fire is on the north side of Kenai Lake, AK in timber blow down from spruce beetle kill. Winds contributed to spotting up to a quarter-mile away. SURVEY LINE, Fort Wainwright, Department of Defense. This fire is approximately 12 miles southwest of Fairbanks, AK. The fire is in a military limited protection area and is approaching a full protection area. Smokejumpers and air resources responded to a slop over near an allotment across the Wood River.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

MARTIS, Nevada-Yuba-Placer Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. A National Type 1 Incident Management Team (Gelobter) is assigned. A Type 2 Incident Management Team has been ordered and the transition will start on 6/27. This fire is east of Truckee, CA and is burning primarily on the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest. Fire activity was minimal and good progress has been made with fireline construction.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

GUAD 1, Carlsbad Caverns National Monument. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Kvale) has been ordered. This fire is near Whites City, NM. This fire is totally inaccessible via ground and suppression tactics were limited to the use of helicopters. Light precipitation was received on the fire. Acreage decrease is due to better mapping.

BLACK, Gila National Forest. A Fire Use Management Team (Cook) is assigned. This lightning caused fire is 35 miles north of Silver City, NM and is being monitored daily.

SNOW, Gila National Forest. A Fire Use Management Team (Cook) is assigned. This lightning caused fire is 30 miles northwest of Silver City, NM. This will be the last report unless significant activity occurs.

OUTLOOK:

Alaska will have weakening high pressure in the south bringing partly cloudy skies and winds. A weak trough in the eastern interior will bring partly cloudy skies and isolated showers. High temperatures will be in the lower to mid 70's with minimum relative humidity ranging around 40 percent. Winds will be north to northwest at 20 to 30 mph in the south part of the state.

High pressure over the desert Southwest will move a little further west which will reduce the amount of moisture moving north into Arizona, New Mexico and all but northwest Utah. This will create partly cloudy skies, with lingering moisture bringing scattered showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 12 to 18 percent in western Arizona and Utah deserts. Winds will be south to southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

Southern California, southern Nevada and northwest Utah will be under a dry southwest flow bringing sunny skies. High temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's in the valleys and 100 to 105 in the desert areas of California and Nevada. Minimum relative humidity will range from 12 to 20 percent, with winds from the west to southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

A cool, moist Pacific trough will continue over northern California, northwest Nevada and southern Idaho bringing partly to mostly cloudy

skies, with scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms decreasing by late afternoon. High temperatures will be in the 70's to lower 80's, with minimum relative humidity ranging from 20 to 30 percent. Winds will be southwest at 10 to 20 mph, except for 20 to 30 mph in northwest Nevada.
