

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, MARCH 30, 2001 - 1000 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Southern Area reported 31 new fires for the week, most were located in Florida and Oklahoma. 28 large fires were contained. Eastern Area reported one new large fire which has been contained. Initial attack activity was moderate in the Southern Area and light elsewhere.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

YOUTH RANCH, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is burning in light fuels in Polk County, FL.

PINE ISLAND, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is in Osceola County, FL.

POINCETT, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Brevard County near the St. Johns River.

OUTLOOK:

A low pressure system will exit the east coast Friday as another broad trough enters the Pacific Northwest. This trough will move across the northern plains and will carve a deep area of low pressure across the western Great Lakes by Sunday bringing a mix of precipitation to the region. The low pressure will move into the Southeast by Monday.

A ridge of high pressure is expected to push across the west by Saturday. Another fast moving system will enter the Pacific Northwest Monday, spreading rain and snow across the north through the remainder of the week.
