

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, MAY 1, 2001 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

New large fires were reported in the Eastern, Southwest and Southern Areas. Initial attack activity was moderate in the Eastern and Southern Areas and light elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire danger was reported in Arizona, Connecticut, New Mexico and Wisconsin.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

SPOT, Florida Division of Forestry. Burn out operations are being conducted to assist with containment efforts.

DUMA JACK, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is located near the community of Sunny Hills, FL. One structure was destroyed.

GROUNDHOG, Cherokee National Forest. This fire is near Hartford, TN. No other information was reported.

COUNTY ROAD 43, Minnesota State Forestry. Some evacuations occurred at the north end of the fire but people have been allowed to return to their homes. Mop up operations are continuing.

RED LAKE 159, Red Lake Agency, BIA. This fire is located 25 miles northwest of Red Lake, MN. No other information received.

OUTLOOK:

*** A RED FLAG WARNING HAS BEEN POSTED FOR PORTIONS OF WESTERN COLORADO AND EASTERN UTAH FOR STRONG WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY ***

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR PORTIONS OF NORTHERN FLORIDA FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND WINDS ***

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR PORTIONS OF NORTHERN NEW MEXICO FOR STRONG WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY ***

A trough moving into the northwest states will produce increased wind in the Southwest, otherwise it will remain dry. High temperatures will be in the 70's in the mountains to lower 100's in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to 15 percent. Winds will be from the west at 15 to 25 mph with gusts to 35 mph on the ridges.

A cold front will bring scattered showers and thunderstorms to Minnesota, Wisconsin and Michigan Tuesday. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 25 to 35 percent. Wind will be south to southwest at 15 to 25 mph, becoming westerly in Minnesota later in the day.

Most of the southeastern states will remain dry due to a high pressure system off the Atlantic Coast. A weak upper disturbance will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms to Ohio and Kentucky. High temperatures will reach 75 to 85 degrees. Minimum relative humidity will be from 35 to 45 percent. Winds will be southeast to southwest at 5 to 15 mph.

A stationary front will bring showers to south Florida, but it will remain dry in the northern portions. High temperatures will be in the 80's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 30 to 40 percent. Winds will be east at 10 to 15 mph.
