

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, MAY 6, 2001 - 0900 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

No new large fires were reported. Initial attack activity was moderate in the Southern Area and light elsewhere. A weak high pressure will build over the Southwest bringing gusty winds and warmer temperatures. High pressure in the South is breaking up, and a weak cold front is moving southward into the Carolinas early in the day and is expected to bring isolated showers to coastal Georgia by the afternoon. A strong storm system from the Midwest will bring rain to Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Tennessee, with moderate to severe thunderstorms possible throughout the day. Very high to extreme fire danger was reported in Arizona, Michigan, New Mexico, Texas and Wisconsin.

OUTLOOK:

*** A RED FLAG WARNING HAS BEEN POSTED FOR NORTHEASTERN FLORIDA AND SOUTHEASTERN GEORGIA FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND WINDS.***

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR WEST CENTRAL, SOUTHWEST FLORIDA AND THE FLORIDA PANHANDLE FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND WINDS.***

A weak high pressure will build over the Southwest bringing gusty winds and warmer temperatures. High temperatures will reach the mid to upper 80's. Winds will be 10-15 mph and gusty across southeastern Arizona and southern New Mexico. The area is expected to remain dry with a low relative humidity of 10 to 15 percent.

High pressure in the South is breaking up, and a weak cold front is moving southward into the Carolinas early in the day and is expected to bring isolated showers to coastal Georgia by the afternoon. It is expected to remain dry over southern Georgia and northern Florida, with temperatures near 90 degrees. Minimum relative humidity will range from 25 to 35 percent, while winds are forecast to be 10-15 mph with higher gusts.

A strong storm system from the Midwest will bring rain to Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Tennessee, with moderate to severe thunderstorms possible throughout the day. High temperatures will be in the 80's, with minimum relative humidity around 45 percent. Winds will be 10 to 15 mph.
