

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
MONDAY, MAY 14, 2001 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was moderate in Southern Area and light elsewhere. Three new large fires were reported, two in the Southern Area and one in the Eastern Area which was contained. Two large fires were contained in northern California. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, Florida, New Mexico and Texas. Forecast dry thunderstorms will travel across western Nevada increasing the potential for initial attack activity. The southwest will experience mostly wet thunderstorms for the afternoon.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN AREA LARGE FIRES:

SIEGEL, Carson City Field Office, BLM. This fire is burning in grass, sagebrush and thick pinyon pine and juniper seven miles east of Gardnerville, NV. The fire made no significant runs. Firelines are holding. Unburned islands of fuel and steep terrain are hampering mopup operations.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

LOPEZ, Everglades National Park. The fire is burning in moderate to heavy fuels one mile west of the Homestead airport. No new information was reported.

OAK, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is eight miles south of Inverness, FL. Firelines were compromised several times due to substantial spotting activity. Aircraft assisted with containment efforts. A burnout operation will be dependent on weather conditions.

GREATER GROVES, Florida Division of Forestry. This human-caused fire is in Lake County, Florida. No new information was received. This will be the last report unless new information is reported.

A-78, Elgin Air Force Base. This fire is in Okaloosa County, FL and was mission-caused. The fire is in longleaf, scrub oak and wiregrass. Mopup and monitoring will continue.

HEMATITE COMPLEX, George Washington and Jefferson National Forests. This fire is near Covington, VA. The fire is in steep terrain and only a small portion allows dozers to work. Crews continue to mopup and reinforce fireline.

OUTLOOK:

The west coast of Florida will be partly cloudy with isolated showers and thunderstorms. High pressure will remain over the rest of the state with high temperatures in the 80's and 90's. Minimum relative humidity will be in the mid 20's to the mid 30's. Winds will be out of the northeast at 10 to 15 mph.

Late Monday, northern California will experience a weak frontal system with increasing clouds. Coastal areas can expect high temperatures in the 60's, inland areas from the mid 70's to lower 80's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 55 to 65 percent on the coast and 25 to 35 percent in the inland valleys. Winds will be from the northwest at 5 to 15 mph.

A weak, slow-moving low pressure system will bring isolated, mostly dry thunderstorms to western Nevada in the afternoon. High temperatures will reach the 70's to lower 80's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 20 to 30 percent. Winds will be west at 15 to 25 mph in the afternoon.

High pressure will remain over Arizona bringing scattered wet thunderstorms in the afternoon. High temperatures will be in the 70's in the mountains to mid 90's in the lower valleys. Minimum relative humidity will range from 15 to 30 percent. Winds will be southwest at 10 to 20 mph.

A weak disturbance moving from the south across New Mexico will support scattered wet thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 70's to mid 80's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 25 to 35 percent. Winds will be southwest at 10 to 20 mph.
