

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, MAY 20, 2001 - 0900 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was moderate in the Southern Area and light elsewhere. Three new fires were reported in Georgia and two in Florida. Northern Florida and Georgia may receive some showers and thunderstorms, but southern Florida will remain hot and sunny with no relief predicted. Cooler temperatures in the Southwest Area will lower the fire danger there. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona and Texas.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

ARABIA BAY, Georgia State Forestry Commission. The fire is in Clinch County, GA. The fire is burning in a large swamp. Active burning has been observed. Extremely dry fuels are causing containment problems.

FAKAHATCHEE, National Forests of Florida. The fire is 30 miles southeast of Naples, FL near Fakahatchee State Preserve. Several structures are threatened. Factors influencing containment efforts include limited access, strong winds and low relative humidity.

CRAWFORD ROAD, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is 20 miles northwest of Jacksonville, FL. The fire was caused by lightning. Low humidity and difficult terrain are causing challenges to containment.

BEAR ISLAND, Big Cypress National Park. This fire is 50 miles east of Naples, FL. Fire behavior increased during the afternoon hours. The fire spread is to the north and east, toward Interstate 75.

HARTSOG, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire, formerly called the Bay Top/Hartzog, is four miles west of Orlando, FL. West winds are still pushing smoke toward Disney World and the other attractions in Orlando. Swampy conditions on the fire are causing problems for containment.

HURST HAMMOCK, Florida Division of Forestry. Mopup operations are continuing on the southeast part of the fire.

VICTOR ROAD, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is 20 miles south of Chipley, FL. No new information was reported.

MALLORY SWAMP, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is approximately 20 miles east of Perry, FL. The fire is in remote, boggy terrain. Winds have impeded containment efforts.

GOLF COURSE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is one-and-a-half miles north of Sea Grove Beach, FL. Crews are working on hot spots and continuing with mopup operations.

SEAGROVE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is one mile from Sea

Grove Beach, FL. No new information was reported.

OUTLOOK:

*** A WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED IN SOUTHEAST GEORGIA AND MOST OF FLORIDA FOR LOW AFTERNOON RELATIVE HUMIDITY ***

High pressure will build over the Gulf of Mexico with a cold front moving across Georgia and northern Florida. Southern Florida will be mostly sunny and dry. There is a chance of thunderstorms in northern Florida and southern Georgia. High temperatures will be 85 to 95. Minimum relative humidity will range from 30 percent to 50 percent. Winds will be southeast to southwest at 5 to 10 mph.

A cold front will move across North and South Carolina, bringing cloudy skies and a chance of showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's. Minimum relative humidity will be 40 to 60 percent. Winds will be southeast to southwest at 10 to 15 mph.

An upper level storm system will move across Arizona and New Mexico today causing partly cloudy skies and a chance of showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's in the mountains, and in the 80's and 90's elsewhere. Minimum relative humidity will range from 15 to 30 percent. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 10 to 25 mph.
