

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
MONDAY, MAY 28, 2001 - 0900 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

New large fires were reported in northern California and Florida. Large fires were contained in Florida, northern California and Oregon. Florida and southern Georgia will be partly cloudy with widely scattered thunderstorms. Nevada will be mostly sunny and windy. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, New Mexico and Texas.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

SILVER EAGLE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is burning in a large dry lakebed and swamp area near Groveland, FL. There are structures around the perimeter that are threatened.

BOG HOLE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is burning in a large dry swamp in Sumter County.

DIXIE/LAFAYETTE COMPLEX, Florida Division of Forestry. This complex, which includes the Mallory Swamp fire, is approximately 25 miles north of Perry, FL.

BLACKWATER COMMAND, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Hillsborough County, FL. Crews will be monitoring and working on containment lines.

APEX, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire in Levy County, FL. Crews continue to mopup and monitor the fire.

CRAVEN ISLAND, Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge. This fire is near Minnies Island. Winds are contributing to the spread of the fire.

BLOUT PASTURE, Georgia State Forestry Commission. The fire is near Darian, GA. in McIntosh County. The fire is in the mopup stage.

RACE POND, Georgia State Forestry Commission. This fire is approximately 20 miles north of Waycross, GA. Mopup efforts continue.

ARABIA BAY, Georgia State Forestry Commission. The fire is near Homerville, GA in Clinch County. No new information was reported.

RACE TRACK COMPLEX, National Forests in Mississippi. This fire is 16 miles north of Gulfport, MS. Crews continue to mopup and patrol the fire. Large swampy areas continue to hamper containment efforts. Burnout operations have been taking place.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN AREA LARGE FIRES:

WARRIOR POINT, Carson City Field Office, BLM. This fire is 50 miles northeast of Reno, NV. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Murphy) has been assigned. Spotting due to high winds cause the fire to jump containment lines late Saturday night and spread rapidly. Air operations were grounded most of the day due to high winds. The fire closed Nevada State Route 445 temporarily.

BULLY CREEK, Vale District, BLM. The fire is burning in grass and sage, 9 miles west of Vale, OR. Gusty winds and accessibility are hindering containment efforts.

WILSON, Lolo National Forest. This fire is burning near Plains, MT. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Sandman) is assigned. Cumulus build up over the fire area created down drafts and high winds with isolated lightning strikes. Containment lines held and significant progress was made on all divisions.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

DEVILS DEN, Lincoln National Forest. This fire is burning in pinyon pine and juniper on the west escarpment of the Guadalupe Mountains 30 miles southwest of Carlsbad, NM. Short range spotting due to winds are hampering containment efforts.

HIDDEN, Lincoln National Forest. This lightning caused fire is 30 miles southwest of Carlsbad, NM. It is burning in pinyon pine, juniper and desert shrubs. Crews continue building containment lines with the assistance of air operations. Containment difficult due to terrain.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR PORTIONS OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL FLORIDA DUE TO LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY ***

High pressure over Florida and southern Georgia will bring partly cloudy skies with widely scattered thunderstorms. High temperatures will be 80 to

95 degrees and minimum relative humidity will range from 25 to 40 percent. Winds will be southwest to west at 5 to 15 mph.

Nevada will be mostly sunny and windy. High temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's and near 100 in southern Nevada. Minimum relative humidity will be 10 to 20 percent and winds will be southwest to northwest at 20 to 30 mph.

Washington and Oregon will be partly cloudy with scattered showers. High temperatures will be cooler, from the mid 60's to lower 80's. Minimum relative humidity will range from 20 to 40 percent and winds will be northwest at 10 to 20 mph.
