

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2001- 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationwide. One large fire reached containment in the Eastern Great Basin Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Utah, Oregon, Texas, Washington and Wyoming.

EASTERN AREA SUPPORT:

NEW YORK CITY CACHE SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Lohrey) is assigned. The team is assigned to manage warehouse operations at Pier 36 and four distribution centers in New York City, NY.

NEW YORK CITY SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A multi-day transition is occurring between Batemans' Type 1 Incident Management Team and Stam's Type 1 Incident Management Team. The incident base is located at the Sheraton New York Hotel. Planning support is located at Duane Street Fire Station. The receiving and distribution warehouse operation at the Jacob Javitz Convention Center has been closed; ground support and transportation remains at the site. Equipment support for Office of Emergency Management operations is being transferred to Pier 36.

NORTHERN ROCKIES AREA LARGE FIRES:

BIRK, Lolo National Forest. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Bennett) is assigned. This fire is ten miles east of Seeley Lake, MT. Some light rain and snow was received on the fire.

BIGGS FLAT, Lewis and Clark National Forest. A Fire Use Management Team (Zimmerman) is assigned. This lightning caused Wildland Fire Use fire is 35 miles west of Choteau, MT. No new information was received. This will be the last report unless significant activity occurs.

OUTLOOK:

Weak high pressure remains over the Northern Rockies area. High temperatures will be 50 to 60 with a minimum relative humidity of 25 to 40 percent. Winds will be south to west at 20 to 35 mph along the northern portions of the continental divide, and 10 to 20 mph elsewhere.

A temporary ridge of high pressure will move into the Eastern Great Basin area, bringing mostly sunny skies. High temperatures will range from the 40s to low 50s in the mountains, and low 50s to mid 60s in the rest of the region. Minimum relative humidity will be 13 to 28 percent, and winds will be west at 5 to 15 mph.

A high pressure ridge will also slowly move towards the Rocky Mountain area. Skies will be cloudy, and there will be isolated afternoon showers over the mountains in Colorado. High temperatures will be 35 to 45 in the mountains, and 45 to 55 in the foothills and valleys. Minimum relative humidity will be 26 to 39 percent, and winds will be northwest at 5 to 15 mph.

A weak front will bring clouds to the northern portion of the Northern California Area. There is a chance of showers in the northwest part of the area. Temperatures will be 60 to low 80s. Minimum relative humidity will be 12 to 25 percent, and winds will be southwest to northwest at 8 to 18 mph.
