

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2001- 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationwide. One large fire reached containment in the Northern California Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Idaho, and Montana.

EASTERN AREA SUPPORT:

NEW YORK CITY CACHE SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Lohrey) is assigned. The team is assigned to manage warehouse operations at Pier 36 and four distribution centers in New York City, NY.

NEW YORK CITY SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A multi-day transition is occurring between Bateman's Type 1 Incident Management Team and Stam's Type 1 Incident Management Team. The incident base is located at the Sheraton New York Hotel, ground support and transportation continue to work out of the Jacob Javitz Convention Center, and planning support is located at Duane Street Fire Station. Equipment support for Office of Emergency Management operations is being transferred to Pier 36.

NORTHERN ROCKIES AREA LARGE FIRES:

BIRK, Lolo National Forest. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Bennett) is assigned. This fire is ten miles east of Seeley Lake, MT. Crews continue to construct fireline on the southern perimeter.

OUTLOOK:

A storm system and cold front will move across the Rocky Mountain Area. Snow showers are likely over Wyoming, western South Dakota and portions of Colorado. High temperatures in Colorado, central Wyoming and western South Dakota will be mid 50s to lower 60s at the lower elevations, and 45 to 55 in the mountains. Western and northern Wyoming will have high temperatures in the low to mid 40s, with 30s to 40s in the mountains. Minimum relative humidity will be 15 to 30 percent in Colorado, 20 to 35 percent in central Wyoming and western South Dakota, and 40 to 55 percent in the rest of Wyoming. Winds over Wyoming and Colorado will be west at 15 to 35 mph, and southwest over western South Dakota at 10 to 20 mph.
