NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light across the nation for the week. Nationally, 53 new fires were reported for the week ending December 27th. Five new large fires were reported and contained during the week in the Southern Area. Very high fire indices were reported in California.

OUTLOOK:

*****A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS IN EFFECT FOR THE FLORIDA PANHANDLE AND WEST CENTRAL FLORIDA THIS AFTERNOON FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY*****

The Southern Area can expect sunny to mostly sunny skies for the weekend, with temperatures rising above normal for everywhere but Florida by Sunday. Showers and storms should begin to occur along the western Gulf on Monday, and wet weather should prevail in Georgia, Florida and the Carolinas for most of New Year s Eve.

Southern California will see a weak ridge of high pressure bring slightly warmer temperatures and light winds to the area. Temperatures will be in the upper 30 s and 40 s in the Sierras, 50 s to low 60 s in other mountain areas and upper deserts, mid 50 s to mid 60 s in the coastal areas and valleys north of Point Conception, and mid to upper 60 s to the mid 70 s in coastal areas and valleys south of Point Conception and lower deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 20 to 35 percent south of Point Conception and 50 to 70 percent to the north. Winds will be south to southwest at 5 to 15 mph and northeast to southeast at 5 to 10 mph south of Point Conception.
