

**INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2002 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2**

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light across the nation. Nationally, 77 new fires were reported. One large fire was contained in the Northern California Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Colorado, Montana, Nevada, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oregon and South Dakota.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

WILLIAMS, Angeles National Forest. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Raley) is assigned. This fire is 25 miles north of Azusa, CA. Fire activity was limited to smouldering in heavy brush. Crews and helicopters are burning out and mopping up.

CAT, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest. This fire is burning in ponderosa pine and oak brush, seven miles south of Alpine, AZ. Minimal fire activity was observed. Personnel are burning out.

OUTLOOK:

*****A RED FLAG WARNING HAS BEEN POSTED IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA FOR GUSTY NORTHEAST TO EAST WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY*****

The Southern California Area can expect mostly sunny skies. High temperatures will be in the 60 s in the coastal basins and mountains, 70 s in the valleys and high deserts, and 80 s to low 90 s in the low deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 20 to 35 percent in the deserts, 35 to 50 percent in the mountains, 40 to 55 percent in the inland valleys, and above 50 percent near the coast. Winds will be southwest to west at 8 to 15 mph along the coast and 10 to 20 mph over the mountains and deserts.

Low pressure moving through the Northern California Area will bring mostly sunny skies. High temperatures will be in the 50 s and 60 s at higher elevations and 70 s and lower 80 s in the lower elevations. Minimum relative humidity will range from 10 to 20 percent inland and winds will be north to northeast at 18 to 30 mph with gusts to 40 mph.
