

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2002 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light across the nation. Nationally, 244 new fires were reported. Two new large fires were reported, one in the Northwest Area and one in the Western Great Basin Area. One large fire was contained in the Northwest Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Washington and Wyoming.

NORTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

QUARTZ MOUNTAIN COMPLEX, Okanogan National Forest. A Fire Use Management Team (Cones) is assigned. This fire is burning in Douglas fir, lodgepole pine and sub-alpine fir, 33 miles northwest of Winthrop, WA. No new information was reported.

ANNIVERSARY, Wallowa-Whitman National Forest. This fire is eight miles southwest of Wallowa, OR, and is burning in timber. No further information was received.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

ROCKY TOP GAP, Cherokee National Forest. This fire is five miles southeast of Newport, TN. Minimal fire activity was observed in hardwood leaf litter and bug kill timber. Crews are constructing fireline. Increased relative humidity aided suppression efforts. Five residences are threatened; structure protection is in place.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN AREA LARGE FIRES:

TWO TIPS, Winnemucca Field Office, Bureau of Land Management. This fire is seven miles east of Fernley, NV. Active uphill running in grass and sage was observed. Helicopters and crews made good progress with fireline construction. Steep and rocky terrain is hampering containment efforts.

OUTLOOK:

Low pressure moving through the Northwest Area will bring partly sunny skies with a chance of showers. High temperatures will be in the 60 s to 80 s and winds will be variable at 5 to 15 mph.

A strong low pressure system moving through the Southern Area will bring partly sunny skies with scattered to heavy showers. High temperatures will be in the mid 80 s and 90 s and winds will be variable at 5 to 15 mph.

The Western Great Basin Area can expect partly sunny skies with a slight chance of showers in the northern portion of Nevada. High temperatures will be in the 60 s to mid 80 s with light winds.
