

**INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
THURSDAY, MARCH 6, 2003 1000 MST  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2**

**CURRENT SITUATION:**

Initial attack activity was light nationally, with 16 new fires reported.

COLUMBIA RESPONSE, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A FEMA Emergency Operations Center has been established in Lufkin, Texas. Three Type 1 Incident Management Teams (Lohrey, Martin and McCombs) are assigned in Corsicana, Hemphill and Palestine, Texas. Two Type 2 Incident Management Teams (Custer, Hildreth) are assigned in Nacogdoches and Longview, Texas. Forty-eight agencies are cooperating with the search and collection of shuttle materials.

NEWCASTLE, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, USDA. State and Federal personnel have been mobilized in response to the outbreak of the Exotic Newcastle Disease. Two Type 1 Incident Management Teams (Corley and Raley) are working in support of the USDA APHIS operation. Support operations are being conducted in Arizona, California, Maryland and Nevada.

**OUTLOOK:**

Warmer temperatures and dry weather will prevail through central Texas over the weekend. The next chance of rain will be Sunday night and Monday as a weak upper level disturbance moves across the region.
