

**INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2003 0800 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2**

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was heavy in Southern California Area, and light elsewhere. Nationally, 56 new fires were reported. Three new large fires were reported in Southern California Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California and Idaho.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

GRAND PRIX, San Bernardino Unit, California Department of Forestry & Fire Protection (CDF). Transfer of command from Dietrich's Type 2 Incident Management Team to Studebaker's Type 1 Incident Management Team occurred on 10/25. This fire is in heavy chaparral, two miles west of Mira Loma, CA. Torching and spotting occurred within the perimeter, and extreme fire behavior due to high winds was observed on ridge tops. Evacuations of Upland, San Antonio, Mt Baldy Village and Lytle creek are in effect.

SIMI INCIDENT, Ventura County. A Unified Command between a CDF Type 1 Incident Command Team (Haines) and Ventura County Fire Department (Sanchez) is in place. This fire is in chaparral and grass, five miles north of Simi Valley, CA. Rapid rates of spread and long range spotting due to high winds continue to hamper control efforts. Evacuation centers have been opened and structure protection is in place in the Simi Valley area. Road closures for State Routes 188, 126 and 23 are in effect.

OLD, San Bernardino National Forest. This fire is in chaparral on the north side of San Bernardino, CA. Structure protection is in place for numerous residences and commercial properties. Extreme wind-driven fire behavior with spotting was observed. Evacuation of the north end of San Bernardino continues.

VERDALE, Los Angeles County. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Osby/Vandenbossche) is assigned. This fire is in chaparral and oak grass, four miles west of Santa Clarita, CA. High winds are causing rapid rates of spread on all flanks, and long range spotting was observed. Structure protection is in place, and road closures for State Routes 126 and 23 are in effect. Evacuations are progressing in Simi Valley and Moorepark areas.

ROBLAR 2, Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base. A Unified Command between a Type 2 Incident Management Team (Domanski) and the California Department of Forestry & Fire Protection (Clayton) is in place. This fire is in chaparral, six miles west of Fallbrook, CA. Minimal fire behavior was observed. A voluntary evacuation for the community of De Luz, and road closures for De Luz Canyon continues.

PIRU, Los Padres National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Dorn) is assigned. This fire is in grass and brush, 14 miles northwest of Santa Clara, CA. Crews continue direct line construction, and mop up along Piru Canyon Road.

PARADISE 2, Sequoia & Kings Canyon National Park. This wildland fire is in mixed conifer and chaparral, seven miles northeast of Three Rivers, CA. Fire activity continues in well developed thermal belts, and roll-out spotting along ridge tops and in drainages within containment lines continues to occur.

RED LAKE 612, Red Lake Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs. This fire is in pine and hardwoods, four miles northeast of Ponemah, MN. No new information was reported. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

RED FLAG WARNING: For central California coastal mountains and valleys, northern San Joaquin valley and adjacent foothills and for southern California mountains and below canyons and passes for northeast winds and low humidity.

RED FLAG WARNING: Red flag warning much of northern California west of the Sierra/Cascade Crest through this morning for low humidity and moderate easterly winds.

Weather Discussion: Santa Ana winds to increase on Sunday with gusty winds prevailing from Oregon across California and into Arizona. High pressure to continue over the West with a disturbance moving into the Dakotas. A cold front will move slowly across the eastern third of the country.
