

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
THURSDAY JUNE 3, 2004 – 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 79 fires reported. One new large fire was reported in the Southern Area. Two large fires were contained in the Southern Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Florida, Kansas, Nevada, New Mexico and Texas.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

PEPPIN, Lincoln National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Bateman) is assigned. This fire is six miles northeast of Capitan, NM in timber. Hazardous terrain, poor accessibility, and heavy dead fuel loading continue to be concerns. Strong plume development occurred yesterday creating containment problems on the northwest flank. Later in the day the plume collapsed producing strong winds and active fire behavior with short runs and torching.

KP, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest. This fire is 20 miles south of Alpine, AZ in brush and mixed conifer. Interior spread is expected as creeping surface fire with group torching continues.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

ROAD 1, Florida Division of Forestry. A Florida Division of Forestry Type 2 Incident Management Team (Jones) is assigned. This fire is 17 miles northwest of Macclenny, FL in pine. No further information was received.

GATOR FIRE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is 35 miles west of Fort Lauderdale, FL in grass. Due to inaccessibility this fire is in monitor status and may continue to burn until a rain event. Smoke has been a problem for Interstate 75, which had to be closed for a short period of time on 6/1.
