

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY MAY 21, 2004 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 924 new fires reported. Three new large fires were reported in the Southwest Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Alaska, Arizona, California, Nevada, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Utah.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

KP, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Kvale) is assigned. Kvale's Incident Management Team has also assumed command of the Rose and Pigeon fires. This fire is 25 miles south of Alpine, AZ in bush and pine timber. High winds caused active fire behavior with torching. Steep, rugged, inaccessible terrain hampered containment efforts.

ROSE, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Kvale) is assigned. This fire is 40 miles north of Clifton, AZ in chaparral. Current hot, dry, windy weather continues to pose control problems.

PIGEON, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Kvale) is assigned. This fire is 30 miles north of Clifton, AZ in Chaparral, and is currently being managed in a confinement strategy.

PEPPIN, Lincoln National Forest. This fire is six miles north of Capitan, NM in timber. Difficult and hazardous terrain, heavy fuels and increasing winds have created concerns.

BLOCKS H&J, Everglades National Park. This fire is 15 miles west of Homestead, FL in grass, brush and hardwood timber. Active fire behavior with occasional runs was observed.

OUTLOOK:

Red Flag Warnings: All of southeastern Arizona and the northern half of New Mexico for strong winds and low humidity.

Fire Weather Watches: Fire weather watch below 8500 feet in south-central and southeast Colorado for winds, low humidity and dry fuels.

Fire Weather Watches: All of northern and eastern Arizona, southern New Mexico, and northwest Texas for strong winds and low relative humidity.

Weather Discussion: Another day of strong winds and low humidity on tap for the Southwest as a low pressure trough remains over the West, with high pressure over Texas and the Southeast. Elsewhere, a frontal system with showers will stretch from the central Plains to the Great Lakes and then into the Northeast. Another area of showers will be found over the Carolinas.
