

**INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT**  
**THURSDAY OCTOBER 14, 2004 0530 MDT**  
**NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1**

**CURRENT SITUATION:**

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 60 new fires reported. Two new large fires were reported, one each in the Southwest and Northern California Areas. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California and Nebraska.

**SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS:**

HURRICANE FRANCES / IVAN RESPONSE, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Muir) is assigned. The Team is managing a base camp at Saufley Field Naval Air Station in Pensacola, FL.

**NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:**

RUMSEY, California Department of Forestry & Fire Protection (CDF), Sonoma-Lake Napa Unit. A CDF Type 1 Incident Management Team (Streblow) is assigned. This fire is 18 miles south of Williams, CA in brush. Poor accessibility and strong winds have hampered suppression efforts. The fire crossed Fiske Creek to the northwest.

POWER, Eldorado National Forest. A transfer of command from a Type 2 Incident Management Team (Wendt) to a Type 1 Incident Management Team (McCombs) will occur on 10/15. This fire is 28 miles southeast of Pollock Pines, CA in brush and timber. Long range spotting over one and a half miles ahead of the fire and significant runs resulted from strong winds. A Boy Scout camp, recreational residences, a campground and a lodge have been evacuated.

FREDS, Eldorado National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Szczepanik) is assigned. This fire is ten miles east of Kyburz, CA in heavy timber and brush. Crowning, torching and long range spotting over one mile ahead of the fire have been reported. A voluntary evacuation of the communities of Kyburz and Silverfork is in effect. Highway 50 is closed in both directions.

**SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:**

GRAMMA, Grand Canyon National Park. This lightning-caused Wildland Fire Use (WFO) incident, located 20 miles west of the developed area on the north rim of the canyon, is being managed to accomplish resource objectives. This fire is burning in ponderosa pine with low to moderate rates of spread.

### OUTLOOK:

**Red Flag Warning:** For Northern California s west slope of the Sierra for strong down canyon (east) winds and low relative humidity levels.

**Weather Discussion:** Strong high pressure remains over the Pacific Northwest with an upper low centered off the southern California coast. This is resulting in gusty winds, low relative humidity levels and hot temperatures over California.
