

**INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
SATURDAY OCTOBER 23, 2004 0800 MDT  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1**

**CURRENT SITUATION:**

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 19 fires reported. Very high fire indices were reported in California and Wyoming.

**OUTLOOK:**

**Weather Discussion:** A cold front associated with a strong low pressure system will move into the Pacific Northwest today. Ahead and along the front, valley rain and mountain snow will be widespread from northern California, northwestward through Idaho and western Montana. The storm that brought high elevation snow to the Rocky Mountain Area will move into the Great Lakes States today.
