

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 1, 2005 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 130 new fires reported. One new large fire was reported in the Alaska Area, and one large fire was contained in the Southwest Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, New Mexico, and Kansas.

ALASKA AREA INCIDENTS / LARGE FIRES:

PILOT POINT, Southwest Area Forestry. This fire is four miles northeast of Pilot Point, AK in brush and tundra. Pilot Point airport was closed. Residences, commercial buildings, commercial fishing boats, and bird nesting grounds are threatened. Creeping, backing and torching were reported.

DOT LAKE, Tok Area Forestry. This fire is 50 miles northwest of Tok, AK in black spruce, mixed hardwoods, and brush. The community of Dot Lake remains threatened. Significant line construction was attained. Creeping and smoldering were observed.

OUTLOOK:

Weather Discussion: A strong trough of low pressure and cold front will push through the northern Rockies and stretch southward into the Great Basin. Ahead of the front, winds will increase across the southern Great Basin and areas of the Southwest while near and behind the front there will be plenty of moisture and cooler temperatures. In Alaska, a weak wave of low pressure will track along a cold front that is stalled across the interior and will again be the focus for showers.
