

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, MAY 10, 2005 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Nationally, initial attack activity was light with 586 fires reported. One new large fire was reported in the Southwest Area. Three large fires were contained in the Eastern, Eastern Great Basin and Southern Areas. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, Alaska, Nebraska and Texas.

SOUTHWEST AREA INCIDENTS / LARGE FIRES:

SUNDAY, Coronado National Forest. This fire is 25 miles southeast of Sonoita, AZ in grass and understory. Smoldering was observed.

OUTLOOK:

Fire Weather Watches: Central and Southern Arizona, most of New Mexico.

Weather Discussion: Gusty winds are expected over the Southwest as a strong storm system moves through the Great Basin. A disturbance will bring showers to the Great Lakes and areas east of the Mississippi River. In Alaska, high pressure will be slowly weakening over the area.

AVIATION WATCH OUT SITUATIONS

As part of risk management, especially during high activity fires, each aviation manager and employee should be asking questions.

- Is the flight necessary?
- Who is in charge?
- Are all hazards identified and have you made them known?
- Should the operation or the flight be stopped due to a change in conditions? Consider the following:
 - Communications
 - Confusion
 - Personnel
 - Weather
 - Turbulence
 - Conflicting priorities
- Is there a better way to do it?
- Are you driven by the task and sense of urgency?
- Can you justify your actions?
- Are there other aircraft in the area?
- Will the pilot accept the mission?
- Are any guidelines being ignored or policies being broken?
- Are communications getting tense?
- Are you deviating from the assigned operation or flight?
