

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY MAY 15 2005 0800 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

Nationally, initial attack activity was light with 57 fires reported. Two new large fires were reported in the Southwest Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Alaska and Arizona.

ALASKA AREA INCIDENTS / LARGE FIRES

ISLAND LAKE, Tok Area Forestry. This fire is 45 miles southeast of Northway, AK in open black spruce and dry tundra. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Jandt) is assigned. No further information was received.

TRACY AVENUE, Kenai Kodiak Area Forestry. This fire is nine miles northeast of Homer, AK in timber. Smoldering in heavy fuels and stump holes was reported.

SOUTHWEST AREA INCIDENTS / LARGE FIRES

GROWLER PEAK, Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge. This fire is 20 miles west of Ajo, AZ in grass and shrub. Active burning with short runs was reported.

ST. CLAIR, Tonto National Forest. This fire is six miles northeast of Scottsdale, AZ in Chaparral. Minimal fire behavior with a few interior smokes was reported.

2000, Phoenix Field Office. This fire is six miles south of Sentinel AZ in grass and desert shrub. Short wind driven runs with flame lengths of five to fifteen feet were reported.

Weather Discussion: High pressure will continue to bring dry weather to the Southwest. An upper low over the Great Lakes with a cold front trailing southward will bring rain to much of the East. In Alaska, a low pressure system in the Gulf of Alaska will spread moisture into the southern and central portions of the state.
